- 4. evaluate integrated features of mobile devices and create applications that access the mobile devices' features. (Accelerometer, GPS, multi-touch, gestures, etc...).
- 5. create stunning environmental effects by applying lighting techniques and mapping appropriate textures.
- 6. develop web based animations and test video and audio using rich media applications.
- 7. design and create functioning games and applications for leading mobile devices.
- 8. create a variety of documents, including a project management plan using project management software, and demonstrate project management skills by achieving set deliverables.

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
